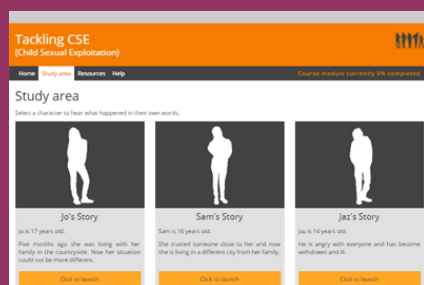


Free training webinars - new sessions and recordings
