Thank you for considering a legacy.

How to leave a legacy

There are several common forms of legacy. E.g. an amount, a residue of an estate, non-cash gifts such as stocks and shares, works of art and other possessions. We strongly recommend that you seek professional advice in deciding which is the most appropriate for you. <u>Find a solicitor</u>. Tell your solicitor you wish to leave a gift to BAMT in your will. Some suggested wording could be

If you would like your gift to be used for a specific purpose, it would be best to wish without stipulating it as a binding obligation. This means BAMT will have the tist discretion in making the best possible use of your gift, while still carrying closely as possible, in line with the needs of the charity at the time when it is reconstituted.	ne flexibility to use out your wishes as
