The site of each congress is determined by a bid process undertaken by the World Federation of Music Therapy (WFMT) Council six years in advance, and the WCMT is hosted by a WFMT organizational member in conjunction with a local host. The 2023 WFMT organizational member is the Canadian Association for Music Therapy, and it has a representative (congress convener) on the Council of the WFMT during the term the World Congress is going to take place.

This is a special event and a unique opportunity to reconnect in-person with colleagues from around the globe although the Congress will be offered in a hybrid format, with both in-person and virtual attendance options to make the event as accessible as possible for as many people as possible.
