As a charity, we are committed to promoting and raising awareness of Music Therapy, developing understanding of Music Therapy through providing information to the general public, and supporting the advancement of education, research and professional practice.

BAMT DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

The BAMT Development Scheme for Newly Qualified Music Therapists (NQMT) will provide a programme that builds on pre-registration training to support therapists during their first 2 years of practice. It will up-skill and nurture therapists in order to build the best foundations for a successful career. The scheme will provide a combination of specialist CPD & expert lectures for the NQMT cohort as well as group mentoring. Year 2 of the programme will have part peer led CPD sessions/lectures and bi-monthly group mentoring sessions.

The scheme will initially run as a pilot programme and will have capacity for 25 NQMTs. To be eligible for the scheme Music Therapists must have qualified from their training course in 2022 and be a BAMT member.



PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

Year 1:

- 10 Specialist CPD/Lecture Events
- 10-12 x Group Mentoring Session (depending on start date)
- Reflective Project
- End of Year Celebration
- Interactive Platform to interact with other therapist throughout the year.

Year 2:

- 6 Specialist CPD/Lecture Events + Additional Peer Learning Events
- 6 Group Mentoring Sessions
- Reflective Project
- End of Year Celebration
- Interactive Platform to interact with other therapist throughout the year.

Mentoring:

Small group mentoring from experience Music Therapists who:

- Hold a mentoring qualification
- Are passionate to grow & nurture the next generation of therapists.
- Have an understanding that mentoring is different, and separate to, clinical supervision.
- Representative of the diverse workforce we are seeking to create.
- Are BAMT & HCPC Registered.
